Who am I? A question for Lent

ent is a 40-day season of reflection and self-discipline before the celebrations of Easter, replicating the withdrawal of Jesus into the wilderness to fast and pray in preparation for his mission. For the church this is a time of self-reflection, prayer and penance. In our secular society Lent has become more of an encouragement to abstinence in order to shed those stubborn Christmas pounds prior to squeezing into the summer wardrobe. I encourage both.

Whatever your faith Lent offers the time and space for each one of us to take a good look at ourselves, our relationships with our families, friends, neighbours, and God – but starting with our relationship with the "self".

"Who am I?" can be approached from a number of perspectives.

The biologists categorise us as *Homo sapiens*, an evolving carbon-based life-form which is about 70 per cent water. The historians tell the story of our humanity, recording and interpreting past events which give identity to the nations in which we live. The bureaucrats would like to reduce us to identity cards (name, date of birth, National

Insurance number, address, post code). The physicist Brian Cox and the psalmist (Psalm 8) both look at the night sky and ponder both the vastness of the physical universe and the wonder of our place in it.

Contemporary society views us as consumers and customers, identifying us through the products we buy, the clothes we wear and the lifestyle we develop and choose.

But none of these address the deeper question of our uniqueness, individuality and "essence" that reveals who we truly are. We are spiritual beings. This embodiment is a part of our spirituality, as our sexuality is part of our humanity. We explore and express our spirituality through music, art, poetry, faith and prayer, but have become unfamiliar, in

contemporary society, with exploring through question and discussion. "Religious" or not, you are a spiritual being and your life is also a spiritual journey.

IMPORTANT: Revision of the Church Electoral Roll

Do you wish your name to be added to or to remain on your church's electoral roll? If so, action is needed!

Only those who are on the electoral roll may attend a church's Annual Parochial Church Meeting and stand for election as a member of the PCC or as a churchwarden. Under the Church Representation Rules you are entitled to have your name entered on your parish's electoral roll if you:

- (1) are baptised and aged 16 or over;
- (2) have signed a form of application for enrolment; and either
- (3) are a member of the Church of England or of any Church in communion with the Church of England being resident in the parish or (not being resident in the parish) have habitually attended public worship in the parish during the six months prior to the application for enrolment;

or

(4) are a member in good standing of a Church (not in communion with the Church of England) which subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity and declare yourself to be also a member of the Church of England and have habitually attended public worship in the parish during the period of six months prior to enrolment.

Whether or not you have your name entered on the existing electoral roll, last revised in 2007, if you wish to be enrolled on the new roll you must complete a fresh form of application.

The numbers of those included on the roll has to be reported at the Annual Parochial Church Meetings which will be held in April. Therefore the application forms for the new rolls must be returned by *Sunday*, *March 24*, to the person listed below.
