Neighbourhood Plan for the Parish of Gaddesby

The Localism Act of 2011 has given Parish Councils the power to shape what their neighbourhood will look like in the future.

Gaddesby Parish Council has made the decision to take on these new powers and to prepare what is known as a 'Neighbourhood Plan'. Once finalised, it will help ensure that any new housing or business development is controlled and meets local needs in terms of type, location and appearance; that important local green spaces are protected from development and that heritage assets are safeguarded. The Neighbourhood Plan, once approved, will be an important document that must be taken into account by Melton Borough when determining planning applications.

The Parish Council, with professional support, will drive this process forward over the next 12-18 months, but it needs YOUR involvement NOW to make sure that the Neighbourhood Plan truly reflects the needs and aspirations of local people. In the coming months there will be a number of opportunities for you to contribute to the Neighbourhood Plan as it develops and to find out how it is progressing.

We invite you to a launch event which will take place in two locations on the same day: at Ashby Folville Village Hall on Saturday 17th March 2018 between 9:30 am and 11:00 am and at Gaddesby Village Hall between 12 noon and 2:00 pm.
